

ECAM Winter School at KMUTT



On 21 January 2020, marked the opening of “ECAM Winter School short-term program” at KMUTT. The 2-week program is co-hosted between the Joint Graduate School of Energy and Environment (JGSEE) and the International for students of École catholique des arts et métiers (ECAM Lyon) from France. Associate Professor Dr.Pornapit Darasawang, Vice President for Internationalisation gave welcome remarks to the students that will be participating in the program and wishes for a fruitful collaboration with ECAM Lyon for future academic exchanges extended from this program. Mr. Didier Desplanche, Director of ECAM Lyon also gave welcoming remarks and sees a possibility that both KMUTT and ECAM Lyon can offer collaborations in other areas in the future forward. Following Mr.Didier, Associate Professor Dr. Suneerat Fukuda, Director of JGSEE, as co-host of the program, briefly introduced details of the program, JGSEE-CEE and their researches which can be considered further. After Dr.Suneerat, Attaché for Scientific and Higher Education Cooperation from the Embassy of France in Thailand, Mr. Gulliam Da, gave the opening remarks mentioning the benefits from this program that can lead to collaboration in the industrial section in the future. ECAM Winter School is an academic-cultural integrated short-term program that will be held from 20th January 2020 – 31st January 2020. The students will participate in academic lectures on Energy and Sustainability Management alongside with cultural and technical visits to areas inside and around Bangkok.
